

## Rules of Play

RCGA rules govern all play except where modified by *local rules*:

- Out of Bounds** - Any ball outside the limits of the golf course shall be considered out of bounds. **Boundary limits** are defined by perimeter property fences, the internal fence along the walkway near the 12th green, roadways, white stakes or white lines. **Roadways** are defined by the course-side edges of curbs or sidewalks. A ball crossing such roadway or the internal fence at hole #12, and coming to rest on another part of the golf course is deemed to be out of bounds. The **driving range** is out of bounds. Rule 27 pertains.
- Lateral Water Hazards** are defined by **red stakes/lines** and **Water Hazards** are defined by **yellow stakes/lines**. Rule 26 pertains.
- All cultivated flowerbeds, low-lying shrub beds and wood chip areas are deemed to be **Ground Under Repair**. Relief is permitted per Rule 25.
- All buildings, rain shelters, on-course roadways, cart paths, power, cable and sprinkler boxes, survey markers, yardage markers, driving range fence (net portion only) and post/rail fences are to be played as **Obstructions**. Relief is permitted per Rule 24.

## Rules of Course / Etiquette

- All players must register at the pro shop before teeing off, must have their own set of clubs and must wear proper clothing at all times.
- Caution: Players are responsible for any personal injury or material damage caused by their golf ball or golf equipment on the golf course or adjacent property.
- Only non-metal spiked golf shoes or similar footwear may be used on the course and the practice facilities.
- Keep bags and pull carts off all tees and greens, and do not take pull carts between greens and bunkers.
- Power carts are to be kept a minimum of 15 yards from greens. Use cartpaths at tees and greens.
- Please rake traps, repair ball marks and replace divots.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed on the course unless purchased from the beverage cart or the Clubhouse.
- Golf course reserves the right to withdraw playing privileges if course rules are not complied with.
- Bye hole 11A is 118 yards from the yardage sign to the green center.
- Golfers are encouraged to yield to the Broadmoor Golf Maintenance Staff while they complete their maintenance duties on the hole being played. This is to ensure the safety of the worker and the best possible playing conditions for the golfer.
- "Keep the pace" and keep up with the group in front.
